Question 1

a) Assume that you are an economist at the Ministry of Finance and National Planning in Peoples Land Republic (PLR). At a recent senior staff meeting the Minister of Finance expressed her concern over the low economic growth rates recorded during the last three years. Consequently, she directed the Permanent Secretary to identify possible fiscal policy measures that can be implemented to stimulate the economy.

Following the Minister's directive the Permanent Secretary has directed you to explain how the PLR economy can be stimulated by a tax reduction fiscal policy using the Keynesian Cross Model.

b) In Manyika-land Republic there has been a wave of credit card fraud, consequently, consumers have resorted to use cash more frequently in transactions.

Required

Using the liquidity preference model show how these events shift the LM curve.

In Zambia unemployment is a major problem, for example, the 2019 Labour Force Survey Report states that the number of the unemployed population was 428,383. Of the total unemployed persons, 173,109 persons were in rural areas and 255, 275 were in urban areas.
